



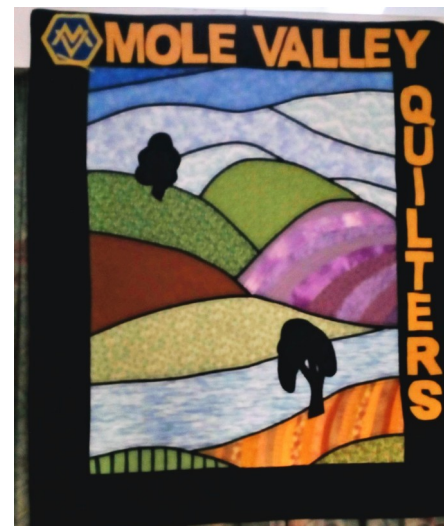

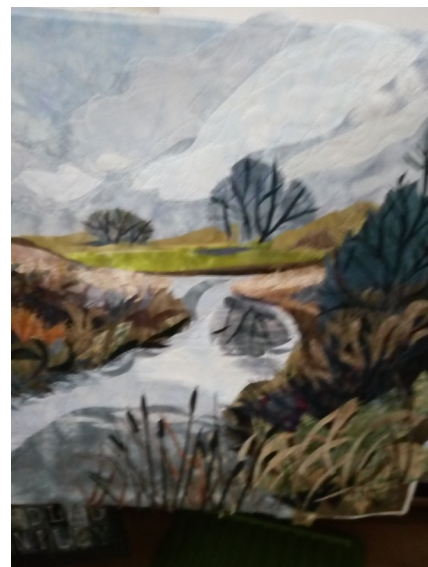

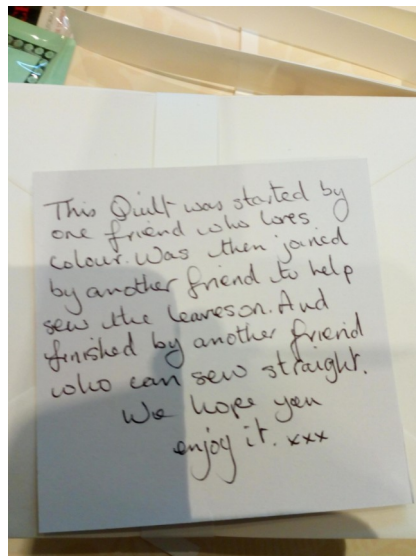

Fork Biscuits (From Eira Warren)

40z (100g) Butter, softened
 20z (15g) Castor sugar
 50z (150g) SR Flour
 Oven 180C/350F/Gas 4

- Lightly grease 2 baking trays
- Measure butter into bowl and beat with wooden spoon
- Gradually beat in sugar, then mix in flour
- Bring mixture together with your hands to form a dough
- Form dough into balls about size of walnut and place well apart on the prepared baking trays
- Dip a fork into a little water and use to flatten the biscuits
- Bake in pre-heated oven about 15-20 minutes until very pale golden
- Lift off baking tray and cool completely on wire rack

(Eira put a small piece of glace cherry on her biscuits)

(for chocolate fork biscuits use 4.5 oz (120g) SR flour and .5 oz (15g) cocoa
