The daffodils are out and it has been dry but cold as we look forward to the spring and Summer and meeting up again.

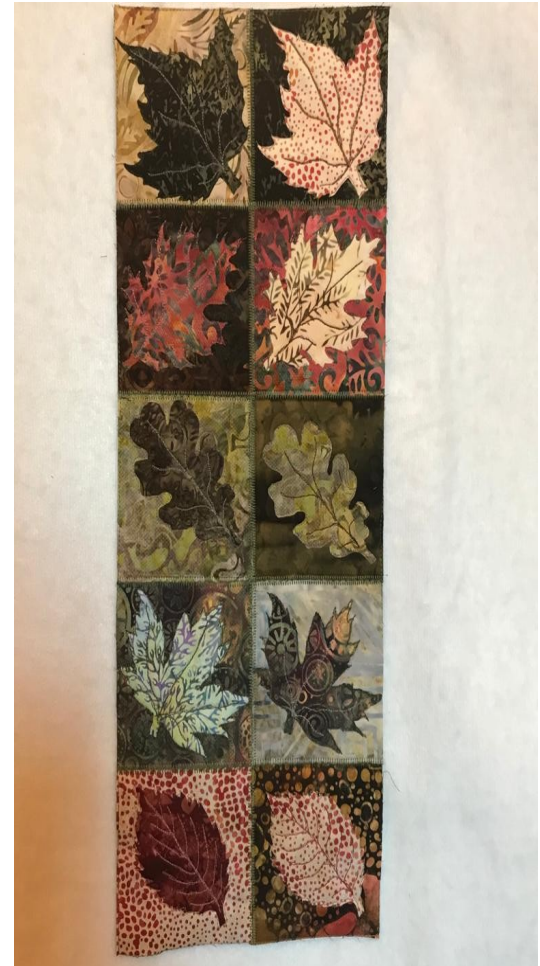
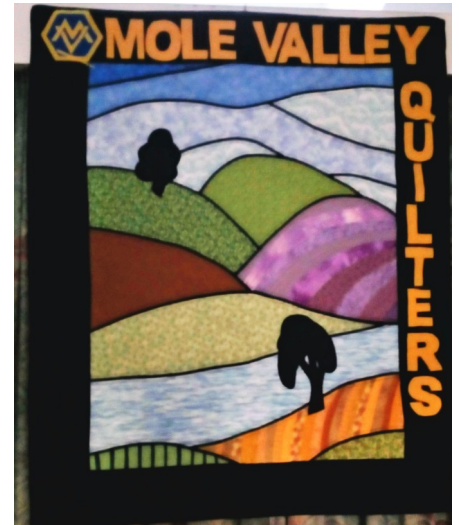
