Flaming June was promised but as I write this the garden is getting a well deserved watering!

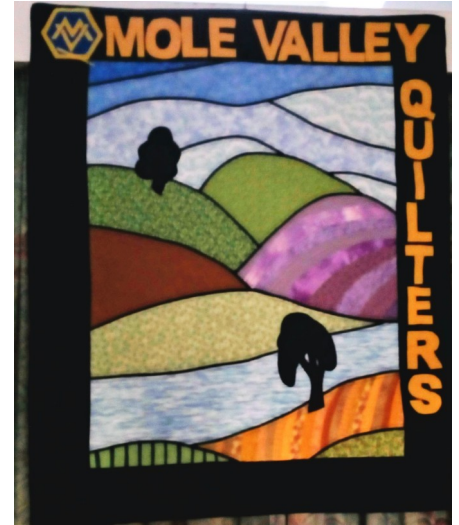
Our June talk was by Judi Mendelssohn and her extensive travels with her quilting group and her quilts inspired by her travels. We had 23 Members including visitors.
