1st Pippa Bishop 2nd Karuna Lawrence 3rd Katherine Clayton


Congratulations to the winners and to everyone who made a challenge quilt. These Challenges were on display at Bookham Village Day on Bank Holiday Monday.

The scout Hut


Message from Gill Harris:


Wadding
