November meeting

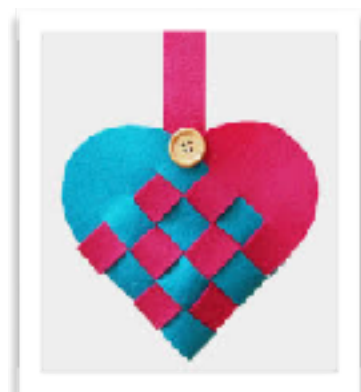
We have an evening of fun makes planned:
